**PROJECT SUMMARY:**

Foley Company installed the mechanical piping at the Kansas City Star's new printing production facility in downtown Kansas City. This project included a central plant with chillers, boilers, pumps, tanks and cooling towers. Additionally, Foley's contract included piping to 42 air handling units within the facility.

Foley also installed the ink piping for the plant. This entailed the installation of carbon steel piping to five (5) ink tanks, high pressure pumps, newspaper presses and a new fill station.

Project required extensive coordination between separate prime contracts for sheet metal, DDC controls, mechanical insulation and equipment purchases.
