PROJECT SUMMARY:

This project required the renovation of four (4) underground concrete digester tanks.

Work included removal and exposure of the concrete tank tops, remediation of soil, and removal of existing hydraulic mixers. Foley's project scope also included installation of new electric mixers, tank cleaning, piping modifications, construction of a new metal building, and crack repair. Work had to be performed in a sequential manner to maintain operation of the plant.

Upgrades to the gas handling and heating system were completed.
